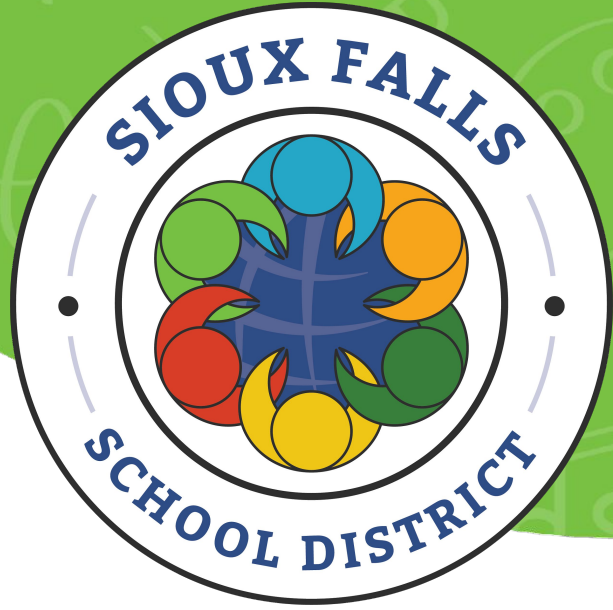

Develop Boundaries for the New Elementary School

New area created from existing portions of Renberg, Hawthorne, and Hayward

One-way Spanish Immersion will be added to the new elementary

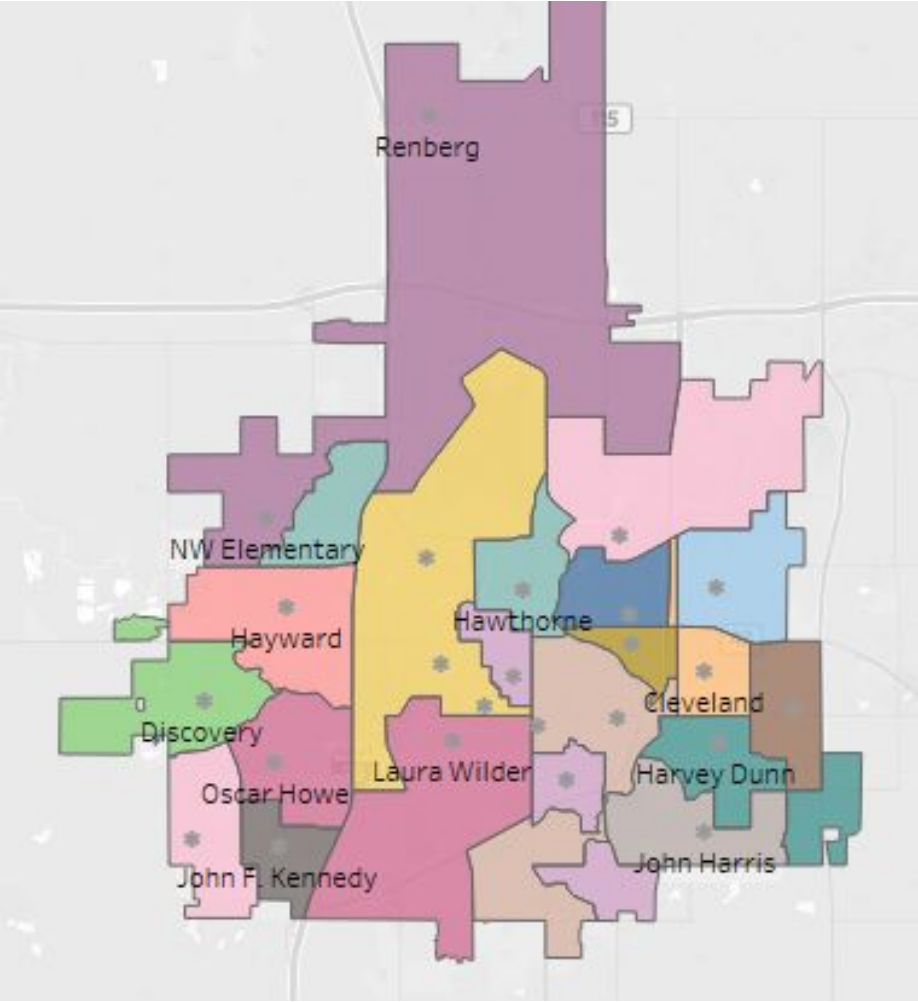
One section of Spanish Immersion one-way at the new elementary school

- Due to enrollment demands at Sonia Sotomayor
 - Increased kindergarten sections for three years
 - Allow the new elementary to open with a kindergarten, first, and second-grade section of One-way Spanish Immersion

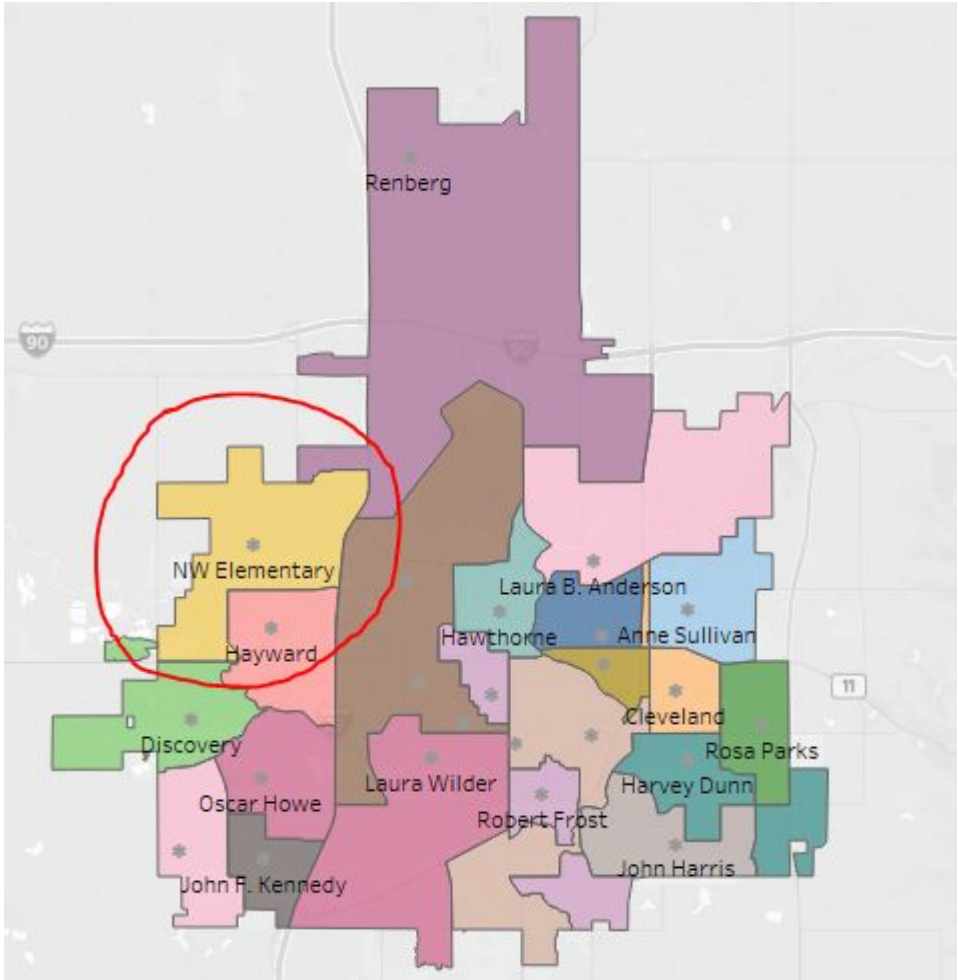

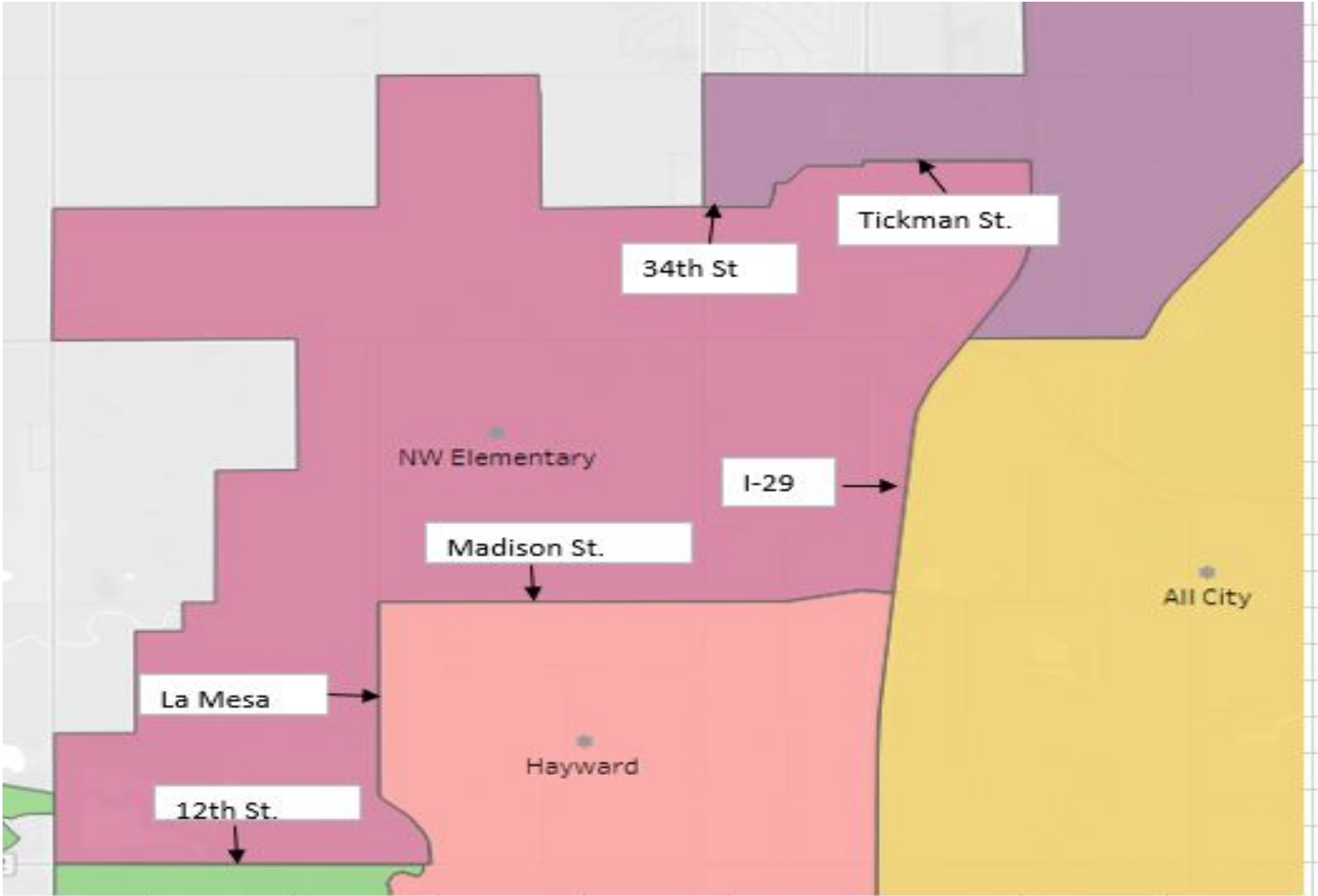

3. Current students in the designated attendance area for the new elementary school will be notified and can elect to remain at their current school through Open Enrollment. Bussing will not be provided to their current elementary school.

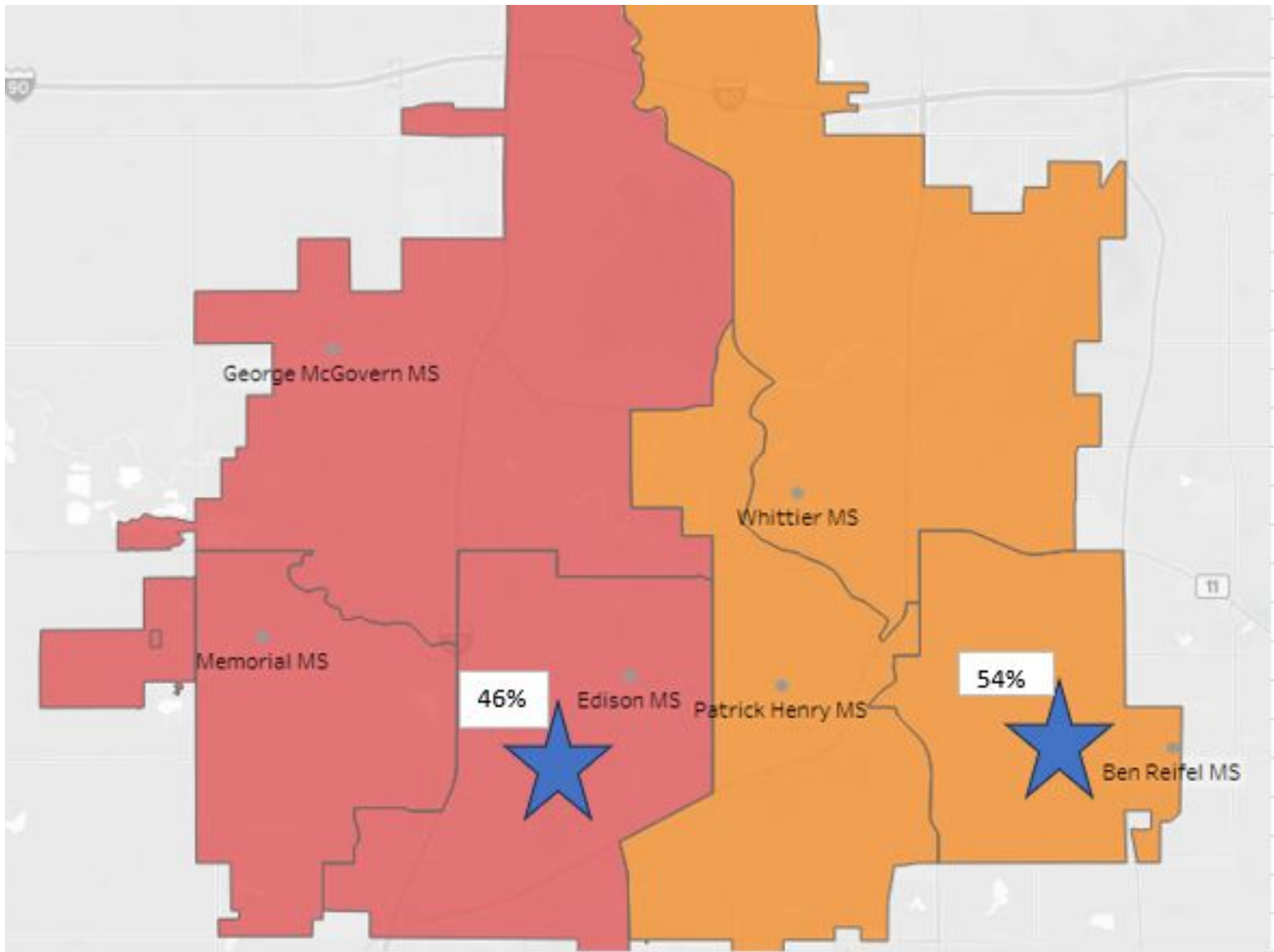

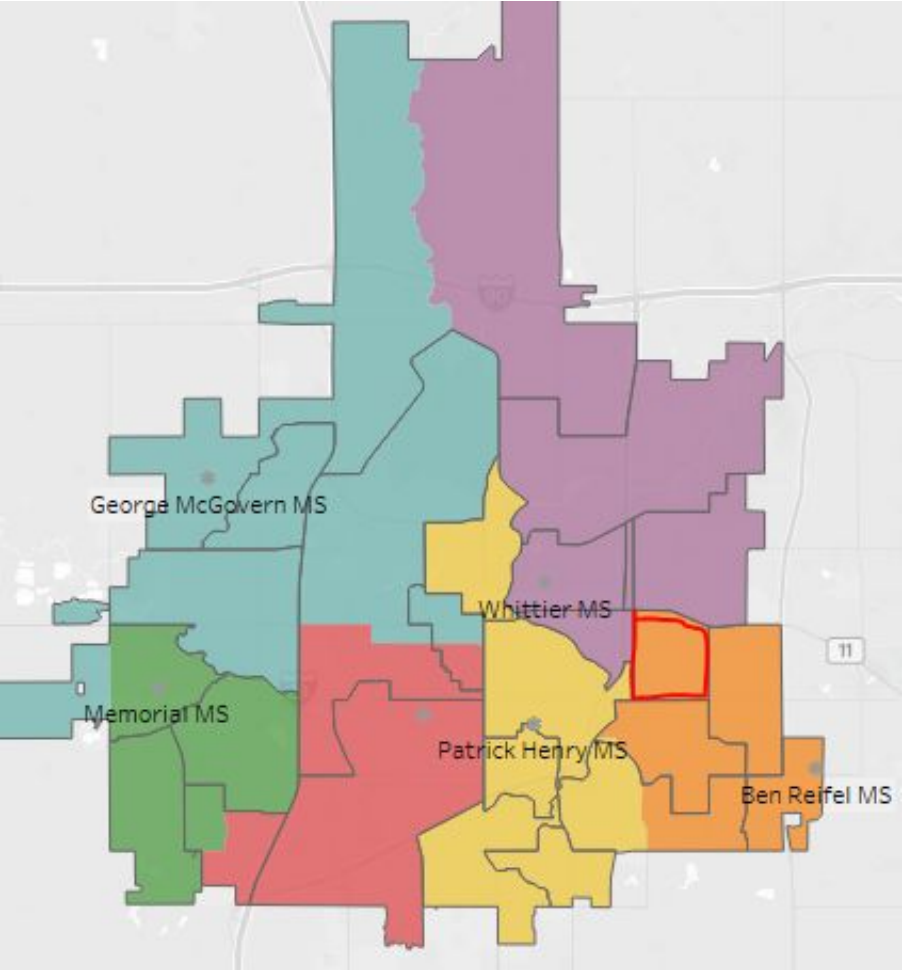
Cleveland to Whittier Middle School



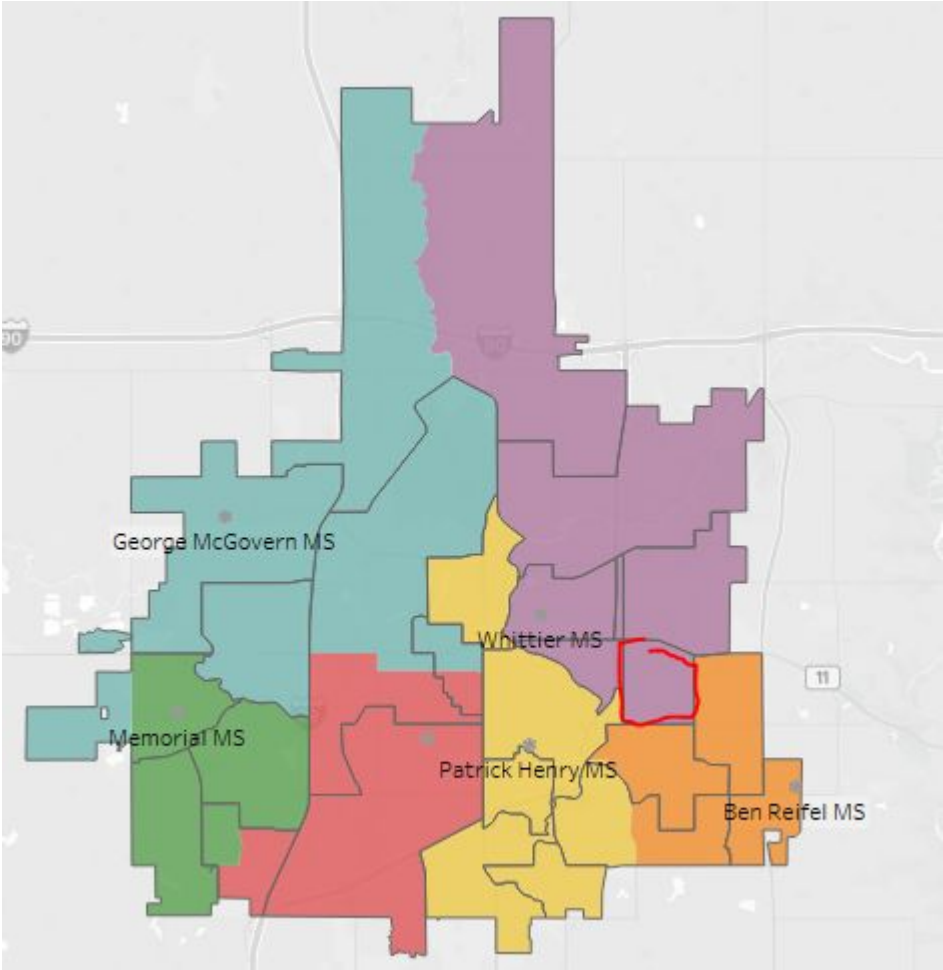


Middle School Impact

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Middle Boundary Adjustment

Fall 2025

Move Cleveland to the Whittier MS boundary from BRMS

6-8 grade students from BRMS to WMS = 172 Students

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Middle School Enrollment

1. Students that qualify for bussing services will receive bussing to Whittier MS from the Cleveland Elementary School attendance area.
2. Fifth grade students impacted by this change with siblings at Ben Reifel MS for the 25-26 school year will be notified and can elect to attend Ben Reifel MS through Open Enrollment. They will not receive bussing services to Ben Reifel MS.
3. Current Ben Reifel MS students impacted by this change will be notified and can elect to remain at their current school of Ben Reifel MS through Open Enrollment. Bussing will not be provided for open enrolled students to Ben Reifel MS.

2030	New School Opens

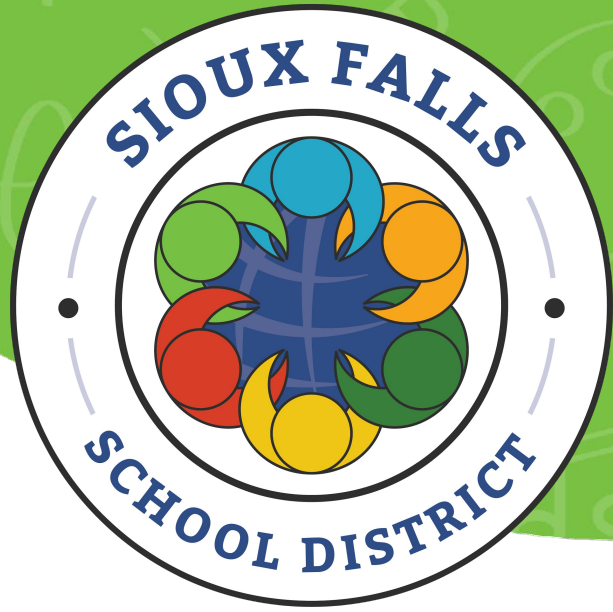


Community Campus
