



ESHS CSF CLUB FAQ's



Q: What is CSF?

A: California Scholarship Federation. There are over 1500 chapters in California. ESHS has had a chapter since the 1930's!

Q: How do I know if I am eligible to join?

A: Use the "approved course list," and add up the points for each grade you earned last semester. A= 3 points, B = 1 point, C = 0 points, D or F make you ineligible for the semester. Qualified students earn at least 10 CSF GPA points each semester.

Q: Where do I find the application and/or course list?

A: Posted in Schoology (see below) or scan the QR code here.



Q: I joined last year/last semester, do I need to join again?

A: Yes, membership must be renewed each semester

Q: How much does it cost to join?

A: \$10 donation/semester.

Q: What does the \$10 donation go towards?

A: Dues to the California CSF organization, scholarships for ESHS students, recognition for ESHS CSF Sealbearer graduates and other club activities.

Q: What types of community service count for hours?

A: Hours must promote academics and/or leadership. See the document posted in Schoology for options. Some examples include: Tutoring at lunch or in the Eagle Academic Support Center, facilitate the RSS Math Club, CSF Club duties, or hold a student leadership position in the ESHS PTSA.

Q: How do you remain an "Active Member" each semester?

A: Submit the application on Schoology, pay the \$10 fee (or complete extra academic community service), complete 10 hours of academic community service and turn in the form (on Schoology).

Q: What are the benefits of joining?

A: CSF encourages the recognition, motivation and education of talented students. Leadership and scholarship opportunities. The CSF motto is "Scholars for Service." Many colleges and universities look favorably on CSF membership when reviewing applications. Members of CSF are eligible for a variety of scholarships available at universities across the state and in select colleges nationwide. Regional CSF scholarships ranging from \$2,000 - \$5,000 are available. In addition, the ESHS CSF Club will award scholarship(s).

Q: Where do I turn in the application and the \$10?

A: The application must be uploaded to Schoology. Add yourself to the proper Schoology class based on grad year, then upload. Class of 2024: NNJD-7JF4-6J56D, Class of 2025: 27QR-FWPH-R3964, Class of 2026: 8NBR-XK7N-66JVM, Class of 2027: JQTX-MDWT-N76FP. Check for \$10 payable to "ESHS CSF Club" can be dropped off at Munger's (A208) or Moeller's (R103) room.
