- I. To qualify for CSF membership this semester, follow these guidelines:
  - A. A student must have taken a minimum of three (3) courses from Lists I and II.
    - 1. At least two (2) of these three courses must be from List I only.
    - 2. Seniors applying for Fall or Spring of 12th grade may use three (3) courses from List II and none from List I.
    - 3. Additional courses may be taken from any List, including List III.
  - B. You must earn a minimum of 10 points per semester.
    - 1. The first 4 points must be from List I (unless you are a senior applying for membership for Fall 12th or Spring 12th).

One additional point shall be granted for a grade of

'A' or 'B' in an AP or Honors class. You may earn up

to a maximum of two such points per semester.

- 2. The first 7 points (including the four points above) must be from Lists I and II.
- 3. The remaining 3 points may come from any list.
- C. You must use no more than 5 courses to qualify.
- D. No CSF points are given for PE, courses taken in lieu of physical education, subjects repeated to improve a grade, office aide/TA, and courses taken on a pass/fail basis.
- E. CSF points are granted as follows:
  - 1. A grade of 'A' = 3 CSF points
  - 2. A grade of 'B' = 1 CSF point
  - 3. Dual enrollment courses do not earn an extra point unless they are H/AP.
  - 4. A grade of 'C' = 0 points
  - A grade of 'D' or 'F' in any course, even in one you cannot use to qualify, disqualifies you from membership for this semester.
- II. Also remember:
  - A. Semester membership is based on work done in the **previous** semester.
  - B. Any courses taken in the summer may not be used.
  - C. You must reapply each semester membership is not automatic.
  - D. To be awarded the status of Sealbearer or Life Member, students must be a member for at least <u>four</u> of their last six semesters for grades earned in 10, 11, and 12. At least ONE semester MUST be Spring of their senior year.
  - E. Use the current approved CSF course for ESHS.
